

Information – Test period for handling of ships generated waste

The test period applies to the following fractions:

Glass, paper, plastic, landfill (complex material), metal, combustible waste and food waste.

During a test period, the Port of Norrköping will receive waste from vessels directly adjacent to the vessel. This is done by placing a container equipped to receive both glass, paper, plastic, landfill (complex material), metal, combustible waste and food waste.



The aim of the changed handling of ship-generated waste is to facilitate the possibility of leaving source-sorted waste and to reduce the risks that can arise when outsiders / visitors move freely within the terminals.

Period

Start 1 October 2020.

Location

Pampus terminal.

Pre-registration

Calling vessels shall notify the types and quantities of ship-generated waste at least 24 hours before the vessel arrives at the port. Prior notification must be made as before in the Swedish Maritime Administration's system for ship reporting, EMSA, Maritime Applications.

Procedure for waste disposal

Upon the reported need for waste disposal, a waste container equipped to receive glass, paper, plastic, landfill (complex material), metal, combustible waste and food waste will be placed directly adjacent to the vessel. It is only in this waste container that the disposal of glass, paper, plastic, landfill waste, metal and combustible waste is allowed. As before, hazardous waste must be disposed of in the hazardous waste cabinet located at berth P2, P6 and P8.

Waste container is dedicated to the ship for a disposal time of 2h. Time for waste disposal is announced in good time via email from the port captain, see below the arrangement of available disposal times.

Additional fee

Extra fees will, as before, be charged for incorrect handling, for example:

- Disposal of waste in the wrong place,
- Disposal of waste with inadequate sorting, labeling or packaging.
